**Goal 3: Provide for a safe and secure transportation system for all users.**

Frequency of fatal and/or incapacitating crashes involving bicycles	Decrease by 5% annually, consistent with the SHSP
Rate of fatal and/or incapacitating crashes involving pedestrians	Reduce the per capita rate of severe pedestrian crashes to fewer than 10 per 100,000 by 2020, consistent with the PSAP
Frequency of fatal and/or incapacitating crashes involving pedestrians	Decrease by 5% annually, consistent with the SHSP
Frequency of fatal and/or incapacitating aggressive driving related crashes	Decrease by 5% annually, consistent with the SHSP
Frequency of fatal and/or incapacitating intersection crashes	Decrease by 5% annually, consistent with the SHSP
Frequency of fatal and/or incapacitating motorcycle crashes	Decrease by 5% annually, consistent with the SHSP
Frequency of fatal and/or incapacitating lane departure crashes	Decrease by 5% annually, consistent with the SHSP
Frequency of fatal and/or incapacitating impaired driving crashes	Decrease by 5% annually, consistent with the SHSP
Frequency of all, fatal and/or incapacitating aging road user crashes	Decrease by 5% annually, consistent with the SHSP
Frequency of all, fatal and/or incapacitating teen driver crashes	Decrease by 5% annually, consistent with the SHSP
Frequency of all, fatal and/or incapacitating distracted driver crashes	Decrease by 5% annually, consistent with the SHSP
Number of schools that have walking school buses	Increase
