




Analysis Updates: LTS & PLOC








Analysis Updates: Accessibility by Biking & Walking

Existing Conditions (Memo I)

2020 ATP

- Assessed existing bicycle and pedestrian conditions
- Outlined importance and benefits of active transportation
- Reviewed existing plans and studies
- Assessed bicycle level of traffic stress
- Conducted equity analysis

- Updated existing bicycle and pedestrian conditions
- Incorporated latest statistics regarding benefits of active transportation
- Included new plans
- Conducted analysis refresh and additional analysis (see Memo V)
- Incorporated Equity Emphasis Areas



Best Practices (Memo II)

2020 ATP

- Summarized bicycle and pedestrian best practice resources (e.g., design guidelines)
- Highlighted bicycle and pedestrian strategies, policies, and codes

- Refreshed all content and policies
- Included standards or guidelines released since 2020, included PROWAG and MUTCD



Bicycle & Pedestrian Safety Analysis (Memo III)

2020 ATP

- Analyzed bicycle and pedestrian crash trends
- Identified collision types
- Highlighted top unsafe segments and intersections
- Listed countermeasures

- Refreshed the crash trends, collision types, unsafe locations, and countermeasures with results from the Safe Streets Pinellas Action Plan
- Retained the top unsafe segments and intersections, while adding the high-injury network developed in the Safe Streets Pinellas Action Plan



Facility Types (Memo IV)

2020 ATP

- Created a facility guide for bicycle and pedestrian facilities including:
 - Infrastructure
 - Crossing treatments
 - Traffic signal features
 - Neighborhood bikeway features
 - Traffic calming

- Updated all previous facility descriptions based on the latest best practices and standards
- Added the following bicycle and pedestrian treatments:
 - Accessible pedestrian signals (APS)
 - Directional curb ramps
 - Adequate nighttime lighting levels
 - Exclusive pedestrian phase / pedestrian scramble
 - Appropriate speed limits for all road users
 - Lane repurposing



Analysis (Memo V)

2020 ATP

- Measured bicycle level of traffic stress
- Analysis bicycle and pedestrian demand
- Conducted equity analysis

- Updated bicycle level of traffic stress and expanded to all roads within the region
- Conducted new analysis:
 - Pedestrian level of comfort
 - Bicycle accessibility
 - Pedestrian accessibility
 - Stress/comfort compared to bicycle and pedestrian access
- Incorporated latest equity analysis and the Equity Emphasis Areas



Project Concept Summaries (Memo VI)

2020 ATP

- Summarized the top ten priority projects
- Each project included:
 - Safety score
 - Integrated and connected score
 - Accessibility and comfort score
 - Quality of life score

- Retained top ten priority projects
- Updated estimated planning cost to adjust for inflation between 2020 and 2024



Summary Report

2020 ATP

- Incorporated primary content from all six memos
- Included ATP Visions, Goals, Objectives, and Performance Measures
- Included evaluation criteria to generate original top ten priority projects
- Recapped public and stakeholder engagement and feedback

- Incorporated all revised edits to six memos
- Minor edit to performance measures
- Included pilot project summary from two demonstration projects conducted since 2020 ATP release
