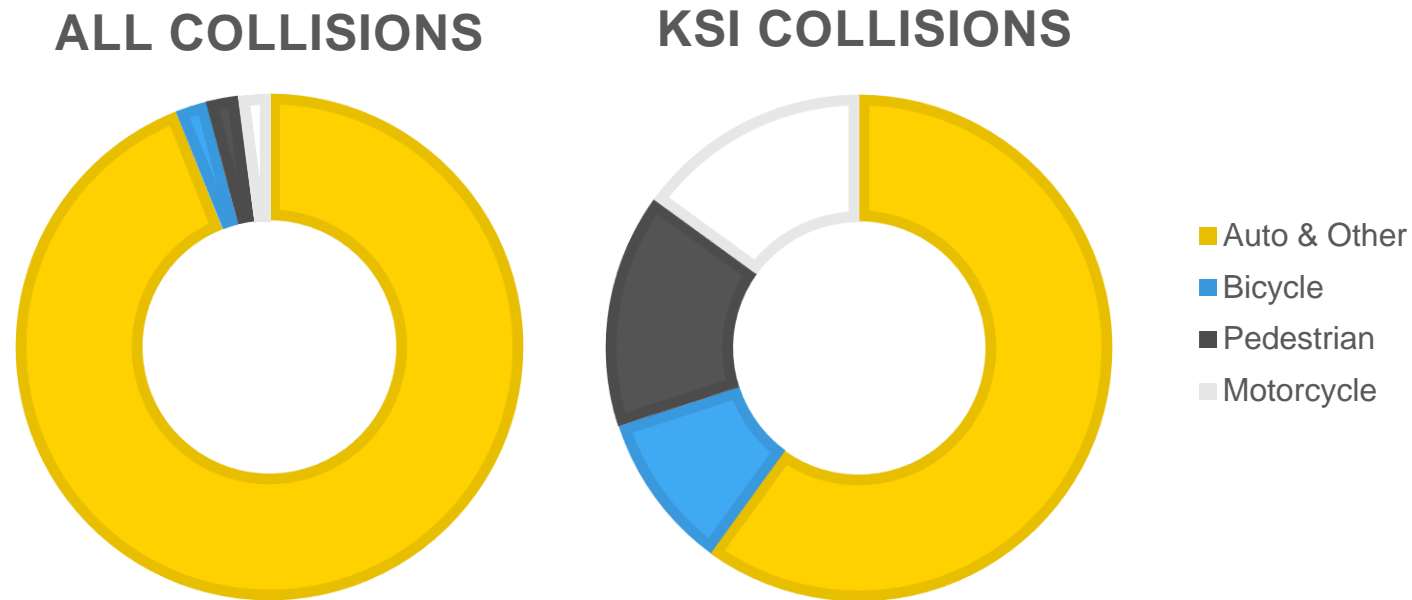

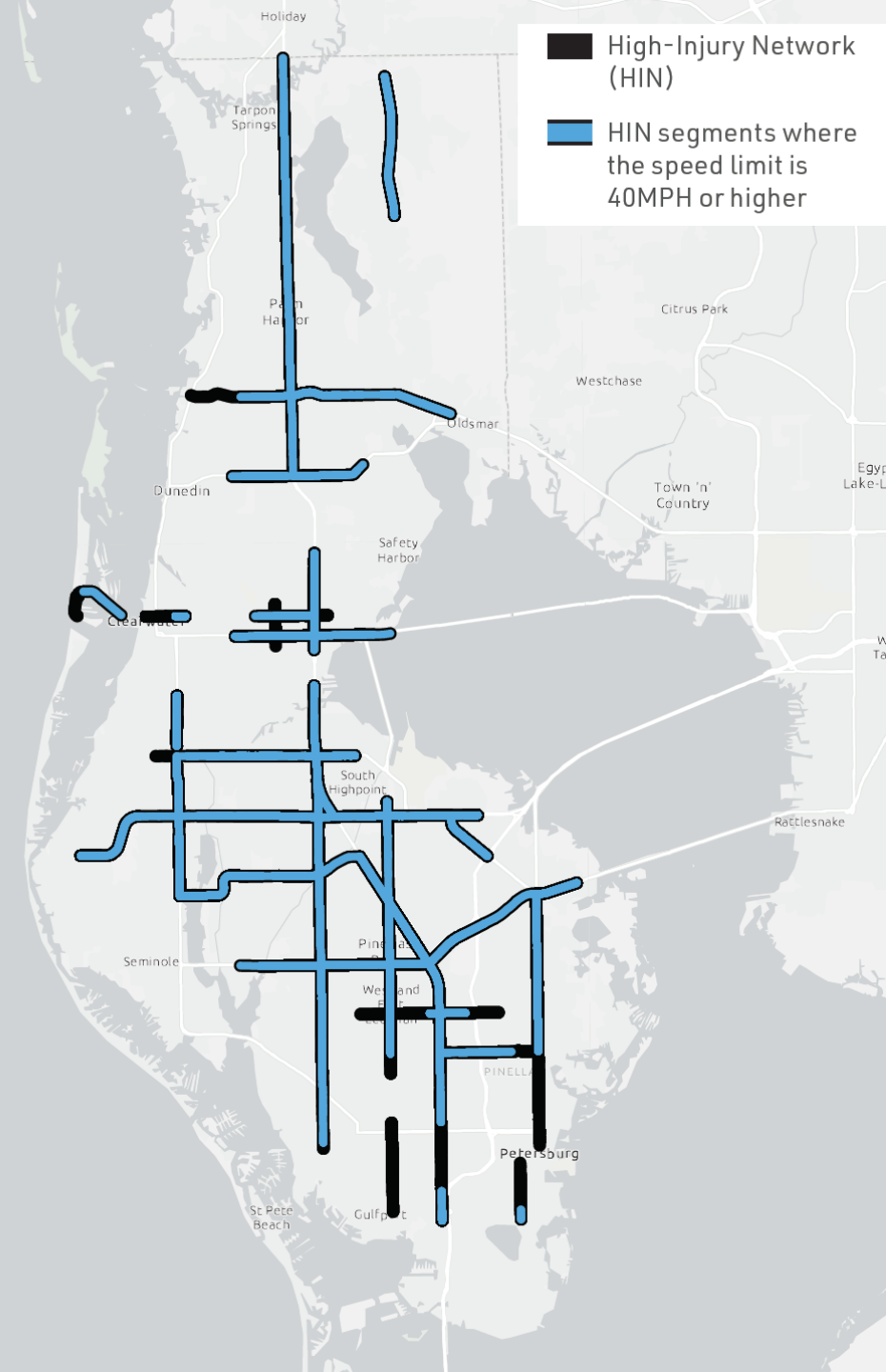
# Why Vision Zero?

On average, 2 people are killed or severely injured in traffic collisions every day in Pinellas County



# Safe Streets Pinellas Action Plan

- Approved by Forward Pinellas in early 2021
- Identified High Injury Network and strategies to move towards zero
- Safe Streets Resolution Adopted by Forward Pinellas and 12 Local Governments
  - Commitment to work together to improve safety
- Funding opportunity through Bipartisan Infrastructure Legislation



# SS4A Program Overview

- **\$1B in FY 22**
- **Applications due September 15<sup>th</sup>**
- *Joint applications strongly encouraged*
- **Action Plan Grants vs Implementation Grants**
  - Can only submit one per agency
- **20% local match required**
- **\$1M limit per grant application (planning)**



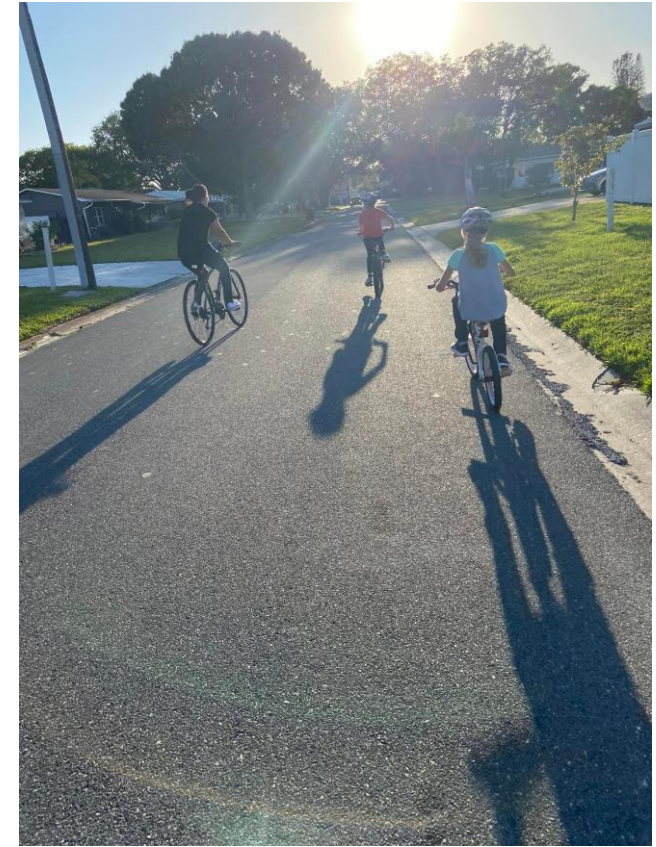
# Forward Pinellas SS4A Grant Application

- **Joint Application**
  - Pinellas County, Dunedin, Gulfport, Largo, Oldsmar and Tarpon Springs
- **Approx. \$100-200k per jurisdiction**
- **Forward Pinellas would manage funds and planning activities**
- **Each Community identified specific area to focus on**
  - Not necessarily focused on HIN; focusing on areas of concern both on/off the state roadway network
- **Planning activities:**
  - Evaluation of specific safety problems in each defined area
  - Detailed assessment of crashes
  - Walking audit with the community
  - Community workshop to vet recommended improvements
  - Presentations to local governing board
- **MOU being circulated for approval by each entity**



# Timeline

- **September 15<sup>th</sup> – application due**
  - **December 2022 – funding announcements**
  - **January 2023 – finalize scopes for each City**
  - **February 2023 – begin planning studies**
  - **July/August 2023 – finish planning study**
  - **Community engagement throughout study timeline**
- 
- **Fall 2023 – consider applying for SS4A implementation grant funding**
    - Forward Pinellas to assist local governments in developing grant applications or adding projects to Forward Pinellas Priority List
