Forward Pinellas Meeting

August 10, 2022

- Transmission System is the main artery of the power supply.
- In this area of the county there are 3 north/south lines





The current Pinellas Trail system is safe.

- a. Lines near current overpasses on the Pinellas Trail have been tested and follow EMF requirements.

The proposed overpass was presented to Duke as a conceptual plan, not as finalized plans, and Duke expressed concerns with the proposed plans because:

- a. The plans could conflict with mid to long range plans to rebuild Duke's transmission facilities in this critical north/south corridor in the county.
- b. Placing an overpass in this area could potentially create clearance issues.
- c. The safety standard that applies to Duke Energy is the National Electric Safety Code (NESC)
- d. Duke's comments were intended to assist FDOT and Forward Pinellas in identifying potential issues with the proposed design, not to create a safety concern.
