1. **CALL TO ORDER**

Carol Cook, Chair Interim called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

2. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES – June 7, 2017**

The summary of the June 7, 2016 meeting was approved as provided.

3. **TAMPA BAY AREA REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY (TBARTA) REGIONAL SCHOOL COMMUTE PROGRAM AND PIKMYKID PROJECT**

Forward Pinellas staff received a late call that the gentleman who was presenting this item fell ill and will be unable to attend.

4. **NEW STATEWIDE STANDARDS FOR SCHOOL ZONES**

Rodney Chatman, Forward Pinellas staff shared that the Department of Transportation has issued new guidance on signing and marking for school zones effective July 1, 2017. Staff members are already working on this new directive. The objective is to enhance and improve driver awareness in compliance with the safety of school children. The changes to the standards are based on school zone flashing beacon assemblies, speeding fines (doubled fines signage) and placement of pavement markings. Casey Morse and Joan Rice with Pinellas County Traffic Engineering, shared information pertaining to schools that currently do not have the school zone flashing beacon assemblies and speeding fines doubled signs can submit a request for funding for the flashers and signs. At this time, Citizen Neil Brickfield was invited to address the committee on behalf of Blanton Elementary School, asking the committee to assist in obtaining signage on 66<sup>th</sup> Street, to announce the schools presence and for drivers to slow down prior to the school rather than when the driver is already in the zone. Ms. Morse and Ms. Rice had all the information needed from Mr. Brickfield to look into his request. Questions were taken and appropriately answered.

5. **REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATION OF STSC BYLAWS**

Mr. Chatman reviewed the committee's previous discussion on this topic and indicated their comments were incorporated in proposal changes to the bylaws. The proposed bylaw changes were coming back to the committee for action to bring the bylaws before the Forward Pinellas Board for approval. Commissioner Eggers moved to have the STSC bylaws brought before the Board for approval. It was seconded by Heather Gracy and passed unanimously.

6. **OTHER BUSINESS**

A. **Hazardous Walking Conditions Update**

Mike Burke with the Pinellas County School Board (PCSB) updated the committee on the Hazardous Walking Conditions survey. PCSB is still working with FDOT on how they wish to proceed on formalizing the process. They are still using PCSB as the statewide example. Senate bill 188 - Public School Transportation is before the legislature in Tallahassee and before the education appropriation subcommittee. It is proposing to transport all kindergarten through 12th grade students affected by hazardous walk conditions. PCSB will win and lose in some instances as far as funding goes. The more serious ramification is that they want to change 1006.21, F.S., to reduce the walk zone for the schools from 2 miles to 1.5 miles. With this change, 30% to 40% more children will be riding the bus. This will add \$10 to \$15 million more in transportation costs for PCSB. A new compound will be needed to hold an additional 100 to 125 buses as well as another 100 to 125 school bus drivers. Bus drivers are desperately needed. Commissioner Jacob Karr inquired about an area in Tarpon

Springs, Whitcomb Bayou, that is prone to flooding, which causes a walk/bike hazard for school children. He also inquired about Anklet Road, indicating that road has no lighting at the bus stop for students who are waiting to catch the bus. Casey Morse with Pinellas County Public Works will get in touch with Commissioner Karr to discuss further.

**B. Pinellas County Schools Five-Year Facilities Work Program (2017/18 – 2021/22)**

Mr. Chatman addressed the committee on the Five-Year facilities work program. This is just an informational item provided by the school board highlighting some of the current work projects for area schools.

**C. Pinellas SPOTlight Emphasis Areas Update**

Mr. Chatman updated the committee on the SPOTlight Emphasis Areas and mentioned the Technology Forum hosted in late September was a successful event with presentations from FDOT, PSTA, HART and two private groups working on different forms of above grade transportation.

**D. STEPS Program**

Steps meeting was cancelled for September; however, other meeting agendas and associated meeting minutes are included in the agenda packet. The schools fared well during Hurricane Irma and there were few issues with the shelters, with the exception of the delayed power.

1. **CALL TO ORDER**

Chairperson Peggy O’Shea called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

2. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES – June 7, 2017**

The summary of the October 4, 2017 meeting was not approved due to the absence of a quorum.

3. **TAMPA BAY AREA REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY (TBARTA) REGIONAL SCHOOL COMMUTE PROGRAM AND PIKMYKID PROJECT**

Mr. Michael Case with TBARTA addressed the committee regarding two separate program partnerships. The first one is the TBARTA Regional School Program, which matches parents together to facilitate Schoolpooling (carpooling), as well as the “Walking School Bus” and “Bike Train” programs. Parents must register at the beginning of each school year to keep the information current. Immediate match results are provided to parents based on their location and school commute. Mr. Pat Bhana with Pik My Kid Project, gave a presentation to the committee. Pik My Kid is a public-private partnership with a Tampa-based technology company using software to streamline the school dismissal process. Pik My Kid is a web-based company using mobile technology that lets parents and school administrators communicate about when a parent is picking up a child from school, when the child is on the bus, when the child is ready to be picked up from school, or when the walking child has left the school grounds. Studies show this system can save schools up to \$43K annually in labor, transportation and traffic management. Pik My Kid was well received by the committee with discussion on selecting a pilot school for a trial run. Ridgecrest was selected for a trial run due to its severe congestion problems with parents and school buses. Fuguitt and Cypress Woods Elementary schools are being considered as well. Questions were taken and appropriately answered.

4. **OVERVIEW OF SENATE BILL 188**

Mike Burke, Pinellas County Schools, shared that the Florida Legislature is considering amendments to Section 1006.23, F.S., which would make substantial changes to public school transportation. Walk radius would be reduced from 2 miles to 1.5 miles and require all public schools to expand transportation to PreK - 12 students who are subjected to hazardous walking conditions. In Pinellas County, this will put 10,000 more kids on buses, and require an additional 125 school buses. Pinellas County Schools is set to purchase 60 more buses and not retire the 60 buses scheduled for retirement. Pinellas County Schools runs approximately 500 buses daily and this would add 120 additional buses daily. As of March 6<sup>th</sup>, SB188 is still with the Appropriations Committee and there has been no movement. (This bill was favored by the Education Committee with an 8-1 vote.) The Hazardous Walk Survey has been postponed until April, after the Legislature concludes. Questions were taken and appropriately answered.

5. **NEW STATEWIDE STANDARDS FOR SCHOOL ZONES UPDATE**

Casey Morse with Pinellas County Traffic Engineering addressed the committee with information regarding the FDOT’s enactment of new statewide criteria for the signing and marking of school zones in the new speed zone manual. Chapter 15, establishes not only school zone and school crossing requirements, but stipulates that all school zones in Florida shall meet the new criteria for signing and markings within five years of the adoption date. All schools must be in compliance by 2022. School speed limit signs will include the flashing beacons and “speeding fines doubled” postings and all school zone pavement markings will be repainted, in coordination with resurfacing projects. School zone times will no longer be posted, the new signs will read “SCHOOL ZONE 15 MPH SPEED LIMIT WHEN FLASHING”. Implementation will be completed in four phases. The first phase

“Outreach” was been completed prior to the new speed zone manual being released. The phase two, “Notification and Request”, must occur in the first year. Pinellas County has inventoried all the schools to establish what materials and supplies each school has on hand now and what materials and supplies are needed for them to be compliant. They turned the inventory list over to FDOT, to determine a budget. In phase three, “Development”, local agencies using this assistance will be required to install and maintain all traffic devices. Pinellas County will make a final sweep to make sure all schools/school zones, including public, private and charter schools, are compliant. This should all be completed in the next five years and up to FDOT standards. Questions were taken and appropriately answered.

**6. OTHER BUSINESS**

**A. Hazardous Walking Conditions Update**

Mike Burke with the Pinellas County School Board (PCSB) updated the committee on the Hazardous Walking Conditions Survey. The Hazardous walk review will be postponed until next month awaiting the outcome of SB188.

**B. Pinellas SPOTlight Emphasis Areas Update**

Sandra Knoebel updated the committee on the SPOTlight Emphasis Areas.

**C. Crossing Guard Press Release 2018**

Ms. Knoebel announced that the City of Clearwater received the Crossing Guard Award from FDOT with a presentation at City Hall.

**D. STEPS Program**

Mr. Burke talked about how effective and efficient the Pinellas County School Crossing Guards are and how well the program works. Pinellas County crossing guards have a total of 4 million safe crossings this school year. The Summer Bridge Program facilitates safe crossings for 16,000 kids over the summer months. A request was made to have the Summer Bridge Program bell times standardized (8:30 – 12:30).

**E. Requests for Future Agenda Topics**

Rachelle Webb from Johns Hopkins Children’s Hospital will be presenting Safe Routes to School at the June 6, 2018 meeting.

**F. Comments**

Joshua Shulman commented that PSTA has made every bus a *safe place for kids / for anyone*, with procedures in place to notify authorities. If someone does not feel safe, they can get on a PSTA bus and let the bus driver know of their fears and the bus driver will contact the authorities. He would like to find out how this information can get into the schools and communities.

Retired Police Chief Williams from St. Petersburg will be asked to join us next meeting. Next meeting date June 6, 2018.

#### **4. Bike Helmet Program**

---

##### **SUMMARY**

Florida Law requires bicycle riders 16 years of age and younger to wear a properly fitted and secured bicycle helmet that meets the federal safety standard as defined by the Code of Federal Regulations, 16 C.F.R. Part 1203. The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) provides grant funding to the Pedestrian/Bicycling Safety Resource Center, housed at the University of Florida, to promote safe pedestrian and bicycling activities. This includes the provision of bicycle helmets and certification training for helmet fitters. In Pinellas County, the training is provided by the Government, Corporate and Community Relations arm of John Hopkins All Children's Hospital.

Staff members of the Pinellas County Public Works Transportation Division have been certified as helmet fitters through this program. They have been working with students at grade schools throughout the county distributing and fitting helmets. The involvement of Public Works staff aligns with the goal of the county's Strategic Plan to ensure public health, safety and welfare by enhancing pedestrian and bicycle safety.

Casey Morse of the Pinellas County Public Works Transportation Division will discuss this program and the role of County staff at the meeting.

### **5. Hazardous Walking Conditions Report**



---

#### **SUMMARY**

Rule 6A-3.0171, Florida Administration Code (F.A.C.) requires local school districts to assure that county and city officials are advised of hazards involving students walking to and from school. Through its hazardous walk review team, School District staff surveys and inspects the surrounding areas of the county's public schools and produces an annual report on walking conditions. This information is shared with Pinellas County and the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and these agencies work with the School District to address any issues affecting the safety of students walking to and from school.

The most recent hazardous walk survey concluded in April. Mike Burke of the School District's Transportation Department will provide a report on the findings of the survey.

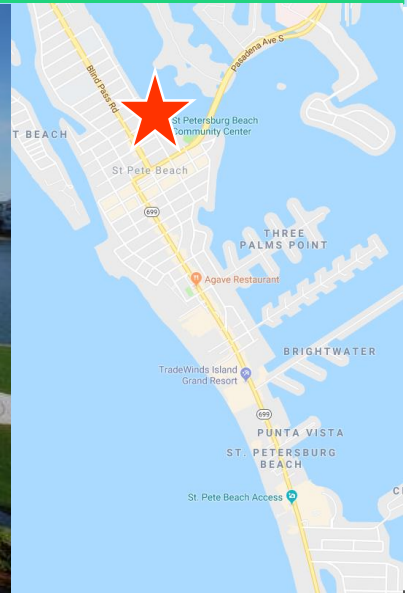

Dear Colleagues:

Beginning with the 2018-2019 school year, many schools will have new start and dismissal times. These changes were made after an extensive review of start times by a cross-functional task force. We listened to input from families, students and employees. In an effort to move high school start times later, the task force worked to review all possibilities for adjusting times while focusing on safety and the ability of school buses to transport students in all grade levels on time.

The start and dismissal times, approved on April 10, 2018, by the Pinellas County School Board, are listed by school online: [School start and dismissal times for the 2018-2019 school year.](#)

- **Elementary and middle schools:** Most schools will see start and dismissal times adjusted by 10 minutes. This does not apply to all schools. Please review the list for information on each school.
- **High schools:** Most high schools will have a 7:20 a.m. start time and 1:50 p.m. dismissal. Four high schools (Boca Ciega, Dixie Hollins, Gibbs, and Lakewood) will start at 7:05 a.m. and dismiss at 1:50 p.m. to support the block schedule of eight periods.
- **Other sites:** Centers and several sites for Educational Alternative Services will have adjusted times. Please review the list for information on each school.

The new times will go into effect with the start of the 2018-2019 school year on Monday, August 13, 2018.

In upcoming school years, Pinellas County Schools will work to make further adjustments to school start times.

Thank you for reviewing this information. You will receive additional details from your school principal as we prepare for the 2018-2019 school year.

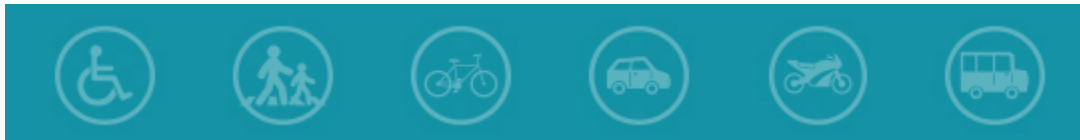

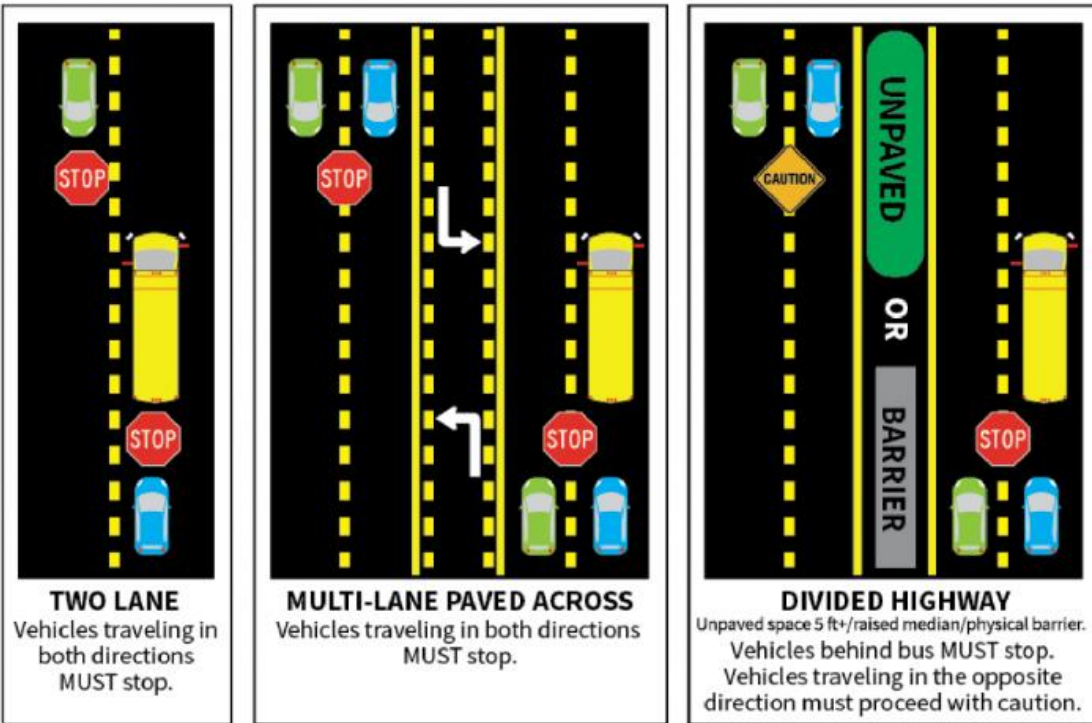

# School Bus Safety



Penalties for passing stopped school bus include:

- Moving violation subject to citation;
- Requirement to complete a basic Driver Improvement Course upon conviction;
- Four points on your driver license and
- Minimum fine of \$165, if you pass on the side where children enter and exit, you will receive a minimum fine of \$265.

On July 1, 2017, the Cameron Mayhew Act took effect in Florida, which increases the minimum penalty for drivers who illegally pass a stopped school bus, resulting in the injury or death of another person. Cameron Mayhew was killed by a motorist that failed to stop as he was walking to his sopped school bus in 2016.

Penalties for passing a stopped school bus that causes or results in the serious bodily injury or the death of another person include:

- Serving 120 community service hours in a trauma center or hospital;
- Participating in a victim's impact panel session or if such a panel does not exist, attending a DHSMV approved driver improvement course;
- Six points on your driver license;
- Suspension of license for a minimum of one year; and
- \$1,500 fine.

## Safety First in Florida - Be Safe, Be Seen and Arrive Alive – Safety Tips for All Road Users



While waiting at bus stops, students should stay away from the curbs and in rural areas students should not sit on berms. Students, should remain a safe distance from the road while waiting for school buses.

Always cross 10' to 12' feet in front of the bus so the bus driver can see you. Also, wait for the school bus to come to a complete stop before moving toward the bus.



Be visible. Wear bright, reflective colors on your clothes, shoes, belts, and backpacks. When sidewalks are not provided, walk towards the flow of traffic (face the traffic) so you can see oncoming vehicles and walk on the shoulder of the road.



Avoid distractions while driving, walking and cycling. Avoid wearing your headphones, texting, or doing anything that takes your attention away from your surroundings. Pay attention while walking to and from the bus stop.



Motorists - Slow down! Speed is the cause of 32% of all fatal crashes. “Pay extra attention to the lower speed limits in school zones. Also, watch for and obey signals from school crossing guards.”



Pass bicyclists safely. Allow at least three feet between your vehicle and the bicyclist. It's the law!



Always use the crosswalk. Push the button to get the walk signal.



“Florida school buses carry precious cargo – our children. Motorists should always be alert and drive with caution around school buses and within school zones.”
