- Maximize efficiency of existing network
 - Incident management
 - Signal coordination
 - Work zone management
 - Special event management
 - Weather management
- Internal culture consider ways to manage the systems to resolve problems

- Utilize lessons learned from other Corridor Coalitions










Next Steps
