- Developed every 5 years to account for latest demographic data, travel patterns and policy shifts
- Allows for ongoing public input for spending priorities



Phase I: Data Development

Statistically Valid Survey

- > 1,146 residents completed
 - > 95% level of confidence
 - > +/- 2.9%
- Some understanding that we cannot keep widening roads to improve congestion
- Technology, maintenance and safety projects are highest priorities
- Regional transit services are widely supported
- Broad support for housing where there are shops nearby
- Strong support for having safer streets in exchange for lower speed limits

 - > Other Arterials






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Strategic Intermodal System (SIS)

- Limited to SIS
 Facilities
- Roads, Intermodal
 Centers, Rail, Ports
- > Allocated by State
- Transit on SIS facilities not included



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Local Funds

- Highly Flexible –
 Covers all modes
- Based on local priorities
- Can be used to match state/federal funds
- Nearly 100%
 committed for local needs






Other Arterials

- For non-SIS state roads
- Can be used for local, parallel/reliever roads and transit
- For non-state roads, must include a 50% local match
- Few state capacity projects and limited local matching funding in Pinellas









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TMA Funds


- Highly Flexible –
