U.S. Unemployment Rate 6.1% (April)


Florida 4.8% (April); Pinellas 4.4% (April)

FY22 Pinellas Planning Council Budget

Budget Summary

- FY22 budget maintains the current millage rate of 0.0150 mils
 - Pinellas County has agreed to restore the local match (\$52,000)
 - Property Appraiser's Office projections has increased (\$81,630)
- Personal services (salaries, benefits, etc.) total \$2,182,930
- Operating expenses (rent, professional services, etc.) total \$2,107,650
- Reserve account slightly exceeds adopted board policy -\$493,120

Budget Summary (continued)


- Primary drivers of the increase in operating expenses are:
 - Professional Services
 - \$600,000 Investment Corridor Study
 - \$250,000 Target Employment Industrial Lands Study Update
 - \$75,000 Pinellas County Design Studio Pilot Program
 - \$60,000 MPO Local Cash Match
 - \$22,000 Granicus Agenda Automation software suite
 - \$15,000 Intern Placement Agreement with USF's Urban & Regional Planning Program


Budget Summary (continued)

- Primary drivers of the increase in operating expenses are:
 - Intergovernmental Services Charges (\$459,100)
 - \$219,100 Information Technology (OPUS, Geographic Info. Systems, etc.)
 - \$231,510 Cost Allocation (County Attorney, HR, OMB, etc.)
 - \$8,490 Risk Management (Admin., Claims, Property, etc.)

- September 9, 2021 Board of County Commissioners adopts tentative FY22 millage rates and budgets
- September 21, 2021 Board of County Commissioners adopts final FY22 millage rates and budgets
