



- Access to services







# Seniors are the fastest-growing demographic group

### According to official State of Florida population projections:

- Pinellas residents aged 65+
   will increase by 28% by 2050
- Residents aged 80+ will more than double
- Residents aged 18-64 will remain virtually unchanged




#### Other needs

#### Allow higher densities

- Independent living units are residential (units per acre)
- Assisted living facilities and nursing homes are residential equivalent (beds per acre)

#### Allow a broad mix of uses

- "Town center" to encourage physical activity
- Medical offices
- Employee housing
- Educational facilities
- May not fit into a single land use category

### Reduce parking requirements

- Supportive transportation services meet many seniors' needs
- Less car ownership means fewer spaces are needed
- Require design for dropoff/pick up

#### **Encourage universal design**

- Homes designed to be used by people of all ages and abilities
  - Entries without steps
  - Slip-resistant flooring
  - Wider doors/hallways
- Require or offer incentives

### **Countywide Rules**

- Local governments may offer density/intensity bonuses for senior housing
- Must design for accessibility and ageappropriate physical activity
- May not locate in the Coastal High Hazard Area

### **Community messaging**

- Provide information on the benefits of senior housing
- Understand and address neighborhood concerns
- Counter perceptions with existing, local examples
- Encourage community allies

- Addressing the high influx of seniors in housing distress
- Roundtables with housing authorities, planners and developers
- Forward Pinellas and Pinellas County staff are participants



# Coordination with other housing efforts





#### **Bay Pines Housing Collaborative**

- Addressing needs of veterans at risk of homelessness
- Bringing together social services, affordable housing and planning staff
- Forward Pinellas staff is a participant

- Model regulations and incentives in the Regulatory Toolkit
- Addressing community concerns in the Housing Campaign
- Data to guide local policy in the Countywide Housing Targets Study
- Online Mapping and Analysis Tools to inform regulatory decisions
