




#### Pedestrian & bicycle travel

(Up from 84%)














#### Working from Home Trends






#### Traffic in Pinellas County












#### Five-Year Trends in Pinellas County (\*2018 – 2022)

## On average in Pinellas County (annually)

- 26,743 crashes (Down 3.4%)
- 122 fatalities (Up 0.8%)
- 3,499 injuries (Down 8%)


#### Fatal Crash Trends in Pinellas County (2022 to 2023)



- SR 590 Safety Harbor Bike Lanes






