

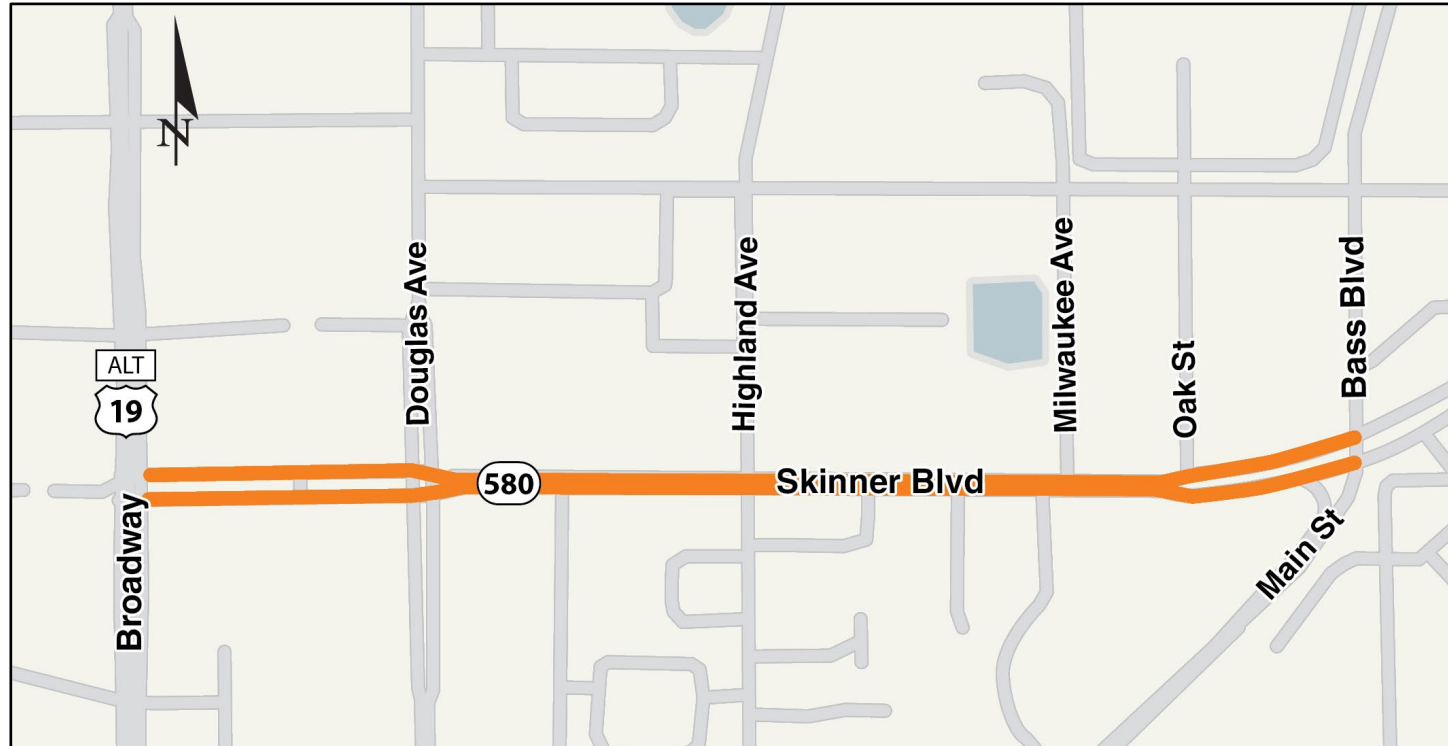

SR 580/Skinner Boulevard From Alt. US 19/Broadway to Bass Boulevard/Main Street



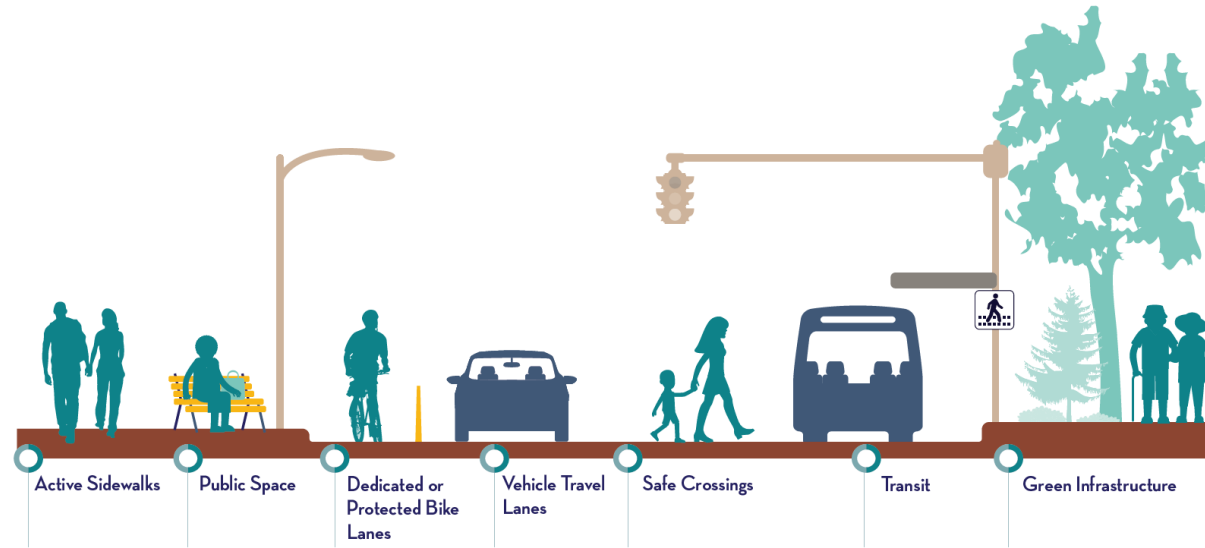

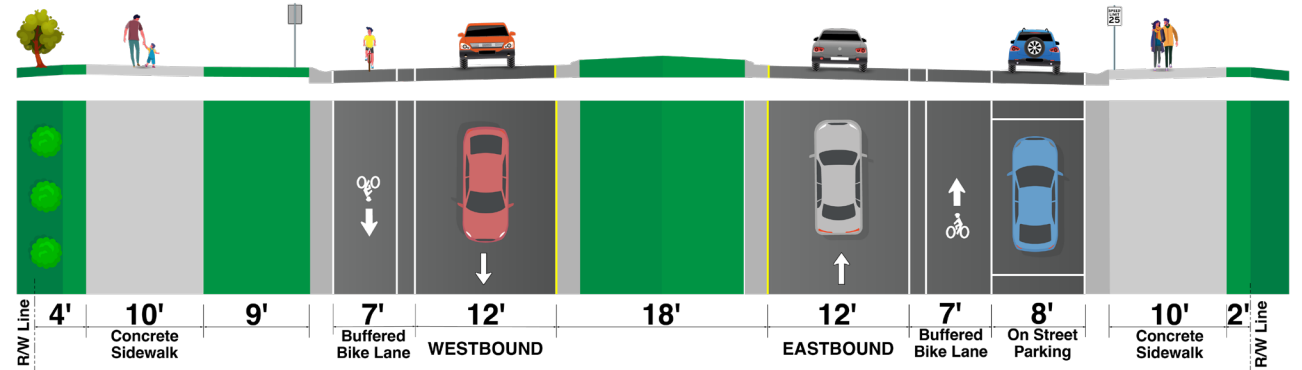

What is a Complete Street?



- Promotes safety, quality of life, and economic development
- Better meets the needs of all users regardless of age or ability
- Based on the context of the roadway and it's surrounding area


- One 10'-12' travel lane in each direction
- 7-foot striped bike lanes
- 10-foot concrete sidewalks
- Raised median
- On-street parking and bus pull-out on north and south side
- Roundabout at Douglas Avenue and Highland Avenue with crosswalks



Typical Section between Douglas Ave and Highland Ave


Traditional Intersection

32 possible opportunities for a collision. Many of those are dangerous, high-speed, head-on or angle collisions.



Roundabout

8 possible opportunities for a collision. Plus, the collisions that do happen are slower and less serious.



- Up to a 90 % reduction in fatalities
- 76% reduction in injury crashes
- 30-40% reduction in pedestrian crashes
- 75% fewer conflict points than four-way intersections
