Gulf Boulevard Visioning Study Virtual Work Session

INDIAN ROCKS BEACH, FL ---- [Forward Pinellas](#) and the [City of Indian Rocks Beach](#) are holding a virtual City Commission Work Session for the [Indian Rocks Beach Gulf Boulevard Visioning Study](#) on August 11, 2020 from 4 p.m. – 6 p.m. At this work session, Forward Pinellas staff will review the comments received from the community over the past year at multiple outreach events. The public will have the opportunity to provide additional comment on the draft report prior to the City Commission taking action on the recommendations. The Visioning Study will create a vision for Indian Rocks Beach that reflects the goals and priorities of the residents, with a focus on the Gulf Boulevard corridor.

“The Indian Rocks Beach Gulf Boulevard Visioning Study will give our City Commission recommendations that will help shape the City’s future based on what residents want to see in their community and what they want for the future of Indian Rocks Beach.
