

- Work with FDOT to advance projects










Multimodal Spending Priorities




Roads: \$1.8 billion Transit: \$420 million Other: \$260 million *numbers above are rounded



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Multimodal Transportation Priorities

- Pinellas Trail Loop
- Bike/Ped Overpasses
 - Harn Blvd.
 - Courtney Campbell Causeway
 - Pinellas Trail @ SR 60
- 18th Ave South bike/ped corridor
- PSTA bus replacements
- Complete streets projects
- US 19 Interchanges
- Recommendation: Develop competitive scoring process to align with Advantage Pinellas






Multimodal Priorities

- Based on MPO priorities
- \$350 million most flexible
 - > Complete Streets
 - > \$1 m annually
 - > Technology
 - > \$1 m annually
 - > Transit Capital
 - Local and Regional
 - > \$200k annually
 - Active Trans. Projects
 - > Trail Overpasses










Proposed Scoring for Multimodal Priorities
