## How to Get Started

Thank you for joining us! This letter will help you get started.



**1st:** A few important rules:

1. Please read over and practice the most recent CDC COVID-19 Safety Guidelines.
2. No nighttime scavenger hunt participation! Please only visit the scavenger hunt locations during daylight.
3. Before heading out, please review our "Tips on Biking and Walking Safely" and visit Florida Bicycle Association website to learn more about bike safety: <https://floridabicycle.org/drive-your-bike/>

**2nd:** Plan Your Trip! Please enjoy the scavenger hunt and keep in mind you do not need to visit all the locations to enjoy in the fun. Only visit as many of the locations as you feel comfortable and make safety your top priority.

**3rd:** Review the Scavenger Hunt Instructions. This document has easy to follow steps for how to participate.

**4th:** Choose Your Process. We have multiple ways you can participate in this scavenger hunt. Feel free to choose which options is best for you or use a combination of the options below:

1. Download and print the "Scavenger Hunt Locations List" and use the hard-copy form to help you find each location. Use the form to check the box for each found spot. 2. Use your cell phone!
  - You can use you cell phone to either scan the QR code at each location, or simply select this link when you find each location: <https://arcg.is/18rXnL>.
  - The QR code will be posted on an event yard sign at each location. In the event a sign is missing or is difficult to find, use the website link above to select which site you have found. 3. Use our online map! Each scavenger hunt location is included in the printable "Scavenger Hunt Locations List" sent out via email and is also identified on our online map. The online map can be used with all of the above options.
